Memorandum of Understanding For Subcontract of Chuuk Lagoon Islands Power System

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between Manibusan & Associates, (hereinafter referred to as Contractor), whose business address is P.O. Box 4922, Agana, Guam 96932, and Beijing Hua Yin Industrial Development (Group) Company, a subsidiary of China Industrial Development Bank, (hereinafter referred to as Subcontractor), whose business address is c/o 13th Floor, No. 1/A Beitaipingzhuang Road, Haidian District, Beijing, China.

Legal Status of Parties

Contractor is a registered business in Guam, and is the main signatory and holder of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Chuuk Government for the financing, developing and constructing capital improvements in the State of Chuuk in the amount of approximately *Twenty-Five Million Dollars* (\$25,000,000.00 USD).

Subcontractor is duly registered in Beijing, China, and is represented by a Guam company, **United Pacific Industries Company, Inc.**, whose business address is 619 Alupang Cove, Tamuning, Guam, 96911.

Scope of Services

Senator Kachutosy O. Paulus (Party A) is the Chairperson of the Faichuk Capital Improvement Programs & Infrastructures who administers all capital improvement projects for the Faichuk Region, State of Chuuk, and identifies the funding for any and all capital improvement projects approved for the Faichuuk Region.

Capital International Investments, Ltd., (Party C) offers an internationally-recognized financing source to Party A for any programs which may require start-up or additional funding for its government projects which comply under the mandated program guidelines of Party C and guarantees payment for all projects outlined in this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

Subcontractor agrees to provide the necessary initial capitalization to finance, develop the property and construct the capital improvement projects pursuant to the required specifications set forth by **Party A**, and stands ready to mobilize its labor force, supplies and equipment for the described purposes.

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Project Description and Terms

In consideration thereof and in goodwill representation and mutual understanding, the parties agree to the following:

1. **Party A** identifies the capital improvement projects to be in its conceptual development and outlines the project as follows:

Chuuk Lagooon Islands Power Plant located at Southfield, Weno, Chuuk State **Purpose:** To provide electricity to Dublon, Fefan, Eten and Uman Islands **Description:** To build power plant on Weno, power transmission and distribution lines and lay submarine cable from Southfield to Dublon, Dublon to Fefan and Uman.

Contractor assures Subcontractor that all other negotiations with any other third parties shall cease and that all future detailed discussions will remain confidential and privileged between Contractor and Subcontractor for the mutual benefit of both parties and expected satisfactory performance for said capital improvement project.

- 2. Party C financially guarantees the funding for said project in an amount not to exceed *Twenty Five Million Dollars (\$25M USD)* to Party A for purposes of funding Party A's above-described capital improvement project which fall under the mandated program guidelines of Party C's financing program.
- 3. Subcontractor makes an offer to finance, develop the properties, and construct the required capital improvement projects, complete and deliver said projects in satisfactory performance under the terms and conditions outlined in a formal Contract between Contractor and Subcontractor prepared to meet all the governing legal concurrence and to be subsequently presented to all parties for execution upon complying and satisfying all required elements mutually agreed upon.
- 4. Subcontractor sets aside Five Million Dollars (\$5M USD) Cashier's Check in the name of the Contractor as its participating fee and good faith deposit in an interest-bearing account for purposes of assuring Party A and Party C of its financial commitment to accept and undertake Party A's identified capital improvement projects. Said account must be held at any of the following recognized the world's top banks:

Chase Manhattan Bank, New York, New York
The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation, Limited, Hong Kong,
Other Bank Approved by **Party C**

- Contractor assures Subcontractor that the Five Million Dollars (\$5M USD) Cashier's Check will have no other party's identification or signatory requirement except the owner of the deposit and account. Proof of Funds must be executed by the Bank's two officers to certify that the Cashier's Check is payable to the order of the Contractor, for the purposes of the above-described capital improvement project for a period of one (1) year one (1) month or thirteen (13) months as required by Party C for the benefit of Contractor and Subcontractor. Contractor may renew the term for another one (1) year one (1) month or thirteen (13) months upon written request to Subcontractor within the duration of the contract.
- 6. Contractor will hold Cashier's Check for a period not less than one (1) year one (1) month or thirteen (13) months as assurance and guaranty of Subcontractor's commitment to satisfy and perform the required contractual services for Party A's capital improvement projects which may be authorized to commence by the end of this year. This Cashier's Check is not, and should not be considered to be, an assignment or a promised tender to any individual, partnership, company, or any other third-party entity. This reserve fund shall not be defined, interpreted or construed as monies owing or due to either Party A or Party C. This Cashier's Check remains under the name of Contractor as sole account holder and shall not have any other authority governing the account except account holder.
- 7. In recognition of its financial strength and its commitment fee to participate and to dedicate and reserve Five Million Dollars (\$5M USD) to Contractor for the award of the above-described project, Contractor and Subcontractor agree:
 - a) On or before August 10th no later than August 14th, the *Cashier's Check* in the amount of *Five Million Dollars (\$5M USD)* in the name of *Contractor* must be deposited at Hongkong Shanghai Bank in Hong Kong with full description and total amount of the project.
 - b) Subcontractor must obtain Proof of Funds signed by two officers of the Bank at which the *Cashier's Check* is prepared and funds are held. The Proof of Funds cannot be more than five (5) days old and must be immediately delivered to Contractor.
 - c) At such time the *Cashier's Check* is not made payable to the *Contractor* by August 14th, an extension may be given for not more than **three** (3) days. Upon the granting of an extension the *Cashier's Check* is not remitted as required for the award of this project, this MOU between and *Contractor* and *Subcontractor* is unilaterally and arbitrarily canceled and terminated, and any and all terms and conditions, sections and subsections become null and void. All documents, project outlines, summaries and cost estimations must be returned immediately to *Contractor*.

- d) Upon receipt of said Proof of Funds, Contractor offers and delivers to Subcontractor for its good faith commitment to accept and undertake the Chuuk Government capital improvement project an advance to be disbursed per month for twelve (12) months at the time the official contract is signed for the express purpose of helping defray initial mobilization expenses. Said monthly advance will be mutually agreed upon at the time an official contract is executed and the Contractor gives Notice to Proceed.
- e) Subcontractor must provide Contractor the necessary Authorization and all required documentation necessary to complete the transaction, forward and file the appropriate instruments with the Chuuk Government and the Guarantor to procure and execute all required actions.
- f) Contractor must give and deliver notices immediately to Subcontractor of any and each separate and distinct act, transaction, activity or reference on the Cashier's Check, both in writing and by electronic communication.
- g) Any act, activity or transaction alienating the terms of the *Cashier's Check* and/or account for such other purposes other than outlined in this MOU shall be considered a reason for **Contractor** to arbitrarily and unilaterally terminate all terms and conditions of this MOU.
- 8. Since the Chuuk Government's 2001 Fiscal Year begins on October 1, 2000, Contractor can only enter into a formal Contract with Subcontractor after and only after the government's budget allocation is authorized and other financing guarantees are secured by the State Government through Party C or other alternative funding sources, such as the Asian Development Bank, etc.
